The ASC is proposing changes to bylaws that will clarify when the ASA By-Election will occur. The changes are meant to adhere to the new Augustana calendar that has been established and implemented by the university. These changes are being proposed in principle because it allows for our By-Elections to be held after the 11 week term has begun. By defining the new dates, students are still able to run for representative positions even if they do not have a class in the 3 week term.

In accordance with the Societies Act of Alberta, these changes will be posted for twenty-one (21) days. If there are no issues brought forth, Students' Council will take a vote on adopting the changes. Items in **red** are the changes. Anything that is **struck out** will be deleted.

ELECTIONS

7.1 Elections

1. There shall be an Annual election before March 31st of each academic year and a By- Election before September 30th of each academic year. The date(s) of the elections shall be set by the Deputy Returning Officer. The following offices will be open for elections: ASA President, Vice-President Academic, Vice- President Finance, Vice-President Communications, and Vice-President Student Life. The additional representatives of the ASA shall be elected from their respective constituencies in the Annual election except for two (2) First Year Reps who shall be elected in the By-Election. The date(s) for elections shall be set by the Deputy Returning Officer.
