Volunteer Corps:

Federal Election:

One of the first things that I tried to accomplish as VP Comm was to secure an Advanced polling station on campus for the Federal Election in October this year. I was unable to get one though, as the Advanced polling stations were set 7-9 months ago according to the Returning Officer. I have made a note of this and intend to pass it along to future VP Comm's for the next Federal Election in 4 years. For the Election, all students on campus will be voting at the St. Francis Xavier Church. As you know that is the new church just south of the University. Students on and off campus will also be able to register and vote at the Returning Officers office in the Duggan mall.

One of my other goals is to have a Candidates Forum on Campus, during the evening, before the election. I have asked Hannah Mackay to mediate again, as she did well at the Provincial Forum in the spring. Once I have more information on this I will pass it along to council.

I am also working on getting the SU's Get Out The Vote campaign to come to Augustana again. I have a meeting with Adam Brown the VP External for the SU later this week to discuss this.

Additional Notes:

Tomorrow the Wellness Wagon will be set up and able to be used. It has been restocked with all sorts of goodies for students. So, if you are looking for something to do during your office hours this week (or through out the year) please take the Wagon through the Forum and Library. It is a good way to meet students and inform people of the ASA.
